



Echo Bay Marina and Lodge COVID-19 Protocols

Updated: July 2, 2021

The Echo Bay Marina and Lodge is open year-round for essential services (fuel, post office, store, field crew use) and we are open for lodging/accommodations and mooring for the 2021 season June 2021 to September 2021.

We are currently accepting bookings from Canadian residents for the 2021 season for lodging and mooring. We will make amendments to our policies once the US and International borders are open as per the recommendations of Transportation Canada.

The Echo Bay Marina and Lodge has developed mandatory BC Worksafe COVID-19 mitigation strategies that have been in place since June 2020. Methods continually change and adapt to meet and, in many cases, exceed the evolving guidelines from WorkSafe BC, Dr. Bonnie Henry, Transportation Canada, the BC Centre for Disease Control, and Forest Industry Standards. We respectfully ask that if you have traveled outside of Canada, or have symptoms (or have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19) that you refrain from visiting our location until a 14-day self-isolation has been completed and you are symptom-free.

The following COVID-19 protocols are in place at Echo Bay Marina & Lodge:

- Mask ban has been lifted - recommended guests 12+ who are not fully vaccinated to continue to wear a mask in public spaces
- Hand sanitizing stations are located around the marina for staff and guest use
- Additional cleaning protocols of all common areas, guest rooms, and staff rooms is an essential part of protecting the health and safety of guests
- Housekeeping staff will not be provide housekeeping services within guest rooms during guests' stay
